

## **Often Asked Questions for Cavalier Products**

### **1. What is the difference between Cordovan, Super Leather and Hair?**

Cordovan is premium leather taken from the rump of a horse. It varies in thickness and is remarkably sturdy and durable. It takes a while to break in but will last longer than any other face. It is the same material that Florsheim uses to make their shoes. It is also a little more limited in supply and therefore is more expensive.

Super Leather is a treated cowhide. It is a little more weather resistant, uniform in thickness and easier to break in but doesn't last quite as long as Cordovan and is less expensive.

Hair is actual hair-on cowhide. Some archers like it because it is so slick. The basic problem with hair is that, when the string comes off the tab, it pulls out the little hairs so that the face wears very quickly.

### **2. What size tab should I use?**

Get the size tab that protects your fingers, specifically, when your fingers are curled around the string, the bottom finger should not hang off the bottom edge of the tab. If it does, it will create painful blisters.

### **3. Sizes of Tabs Hand sizing Chart**

Small Total Size: 2 1/2 down and 2 1/4 across

Index Finger 2 1/4 across x 3/4 wide

Mdlefing/pinky 2 1/2 across x 1 1/2 wide

Medium Total size: 2 1/2 down and 2 5/8 across

Index Finger 2 1/2 across x 3/4 wide

Midlefing/pinky 2 5/8 across x 1 1/2 wide

Large Total Size: 3 down and 2 3/4 across

Index Finger 2 3/4 across x 3/4 wide

Midlefing/pinky 2 3/4 across x 1 3/4 wide

XLarge Total Size 3 down and 3 across

Index Finger 2 3/4 across x 1 wide

Midlefing/pinky 3 across x 1 3/4 wide
