

*We don't recommend using the Long Master Plunger for wrap around rests.*

*We recommend using the Master Lok Plunger for the wrap around rests. The Master Lok barrel is thicker and it was designed for our wrap around rests. That's why there is a hex nut on the barrel, so you can use a wrench to tighten the rest on. The Long Master Plunger only comes with a lock ring for finger tightening and is not designed for holding a rest on. The Long Master Plunger has been used by some people without any problem but if you do use the Long Master Plunger and over tighten the lock ring, it will break the barrel and we don't warranty that.*

*We use the same Teflon material in both the Master Plungers and the Master Lok Plunger. The only difference between the two is that we have taken the extra material out of the stem of the Master Plunger and put it into the barrel of the Master Lok barrel making it thicker. That in turn, makes the stem of the Master Lok smaller. That's why you can use a wrench to tighten you rest to you riser and not have the barrel break.*

*There is only 5/16" difference between them. (The Long Master Plunger is longer.)*
