FLETCH III

Fletching Made Simple Build Identical Arrow Every Time!

Fletch III by AAE is a simple arrow fletching tool designed for archers and bow-hunters. It has a fixed 1-degree offset and fits arrows .240" to .370" in diameter (ACC dia. to 25XX aluminum dia).

Using AAE Fletch III is simple and straight forward. Complete step-by-step fletching directions are available on line at ArizonaArchery.com.

The X-Stand/Arrow Holder is designed for different sizes of arrow shafts. The back side of the X-Stand is labeled with a molded-in "L" (large) and "S" (small) for arrow size. The Large "V" is for arrow shaft sizes .300" and over; the small "V" is for arrows under .300" in diameter.

Directions for using Fletch III:

- 1. Place Fletch III on a table. Snap nock in receiver and rotate to desired position. The nock receiver has a rib that indicates the cock vane position.
- 2. Place vane in clamp. Using the molded rib on the side of the vane clamp as a guide to run your finger along, apple adhesive to the base of the vane and slide the clamp into the alignment holes and press the vane down firmly. Depending on the adhesive you are using, let it set for the recommended amount of time as per vane gluing instructions.
- 3. Remove the clamp, rotate your arrow and repeat the process.
